

Sales Advice and Guidance.

If you are **selling a pony**, it is helpful if you can provide as many details of your pony as possible including:

- Registered name
- Stable name
- Age
- Ability, experience and training level (i.e. ridden, driven, lead rein, brood mare, companion)
- Height
- Any known issues (e.g. sweet itch, laminitis)
- Price sought (not compulsory)
- Photographs if possible

If you are **looking for a pony**, please outline

- what you want to use the pony for (i.e. breeding, riding, driving, showing)
- age bracket sought
- price limit (not compulsory)
- what type of home you can offer (i.e. with other horses, type of grazing etc)
- experience with ponies

Please use the sales form found on the web site as this will prompt you to give the information that will make your advert accurate and informative.

Your advert will stay on for 8 weeks then be removed unless you ask for it to remain on the site. You will not get a reminder as this cut-off date approaches so, please do bear it in mind.

If you no longer need the advert to be on the site, **PLEASE TELL US STRAIGHT AWAY** so you are not bothered by unwanted messages.

If you're **loaning a pony**, you should draw up a loan agreement. The Eriskay Pony Society has a loan agreement template, based on the one provided by the British Horse Society (BHS), and this is available free of charge. Simply email sales@eriskaypony.org for a copy that can be tailored to your needs. Further advice on loaning can be found on the BHS website
